CONTRACT ACCEPTANCE

I, the undersigned, have read and understand this agreement and acknowledge receipt of a copy. It is further understood and agreed that this agreement supersedes all prior or contemporaneous verbal or written agreements and may not be modified without the written agreement of the student and the School Official. I also understand that if I default upon this agreement I will be responsible for payment of any collection fees or attorney fees incurred by Discovery diving Co., Inc.

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Deposits and Payment Schedule:

A deposit of \$65 or \$115, depending on the class, is required as a down payment for all vocational classes. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the total cost of a program is due as deposit upon execution of the enrollment agreement for that program. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the total program cost is due on or before the first day of the program. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the total program cost is due on or before 30 days after the first day of the program. The final $\frac{1}{4}$ of the total program cost is due on or before 60 days after the first day of the program.

Policy/Regulations – Re: Refund

Refund of unused portions of tuition, fees, etc if student does not enter course Students will be refunded the full course costs if they are unable to attend the desired course and have given at least a 30 day notice to Discovery Diving, Co. If the student has not given enough advanced notice prior to not entering, they will be charged an administrative fee not to exceed \$200.00.

Refund Due Dates:

1. If an applicant never attends class (no-show) or cancels the contract prior to the class start date, all refunds due will be made within forty-five (45) calendar days of the first scheduled day of class or the date of cancellation, whichever is earlier.
2. For an enrolled student, the refund due will be calculated using the last date of attendance (LDA) and be paid within forty-five (45) calendar days from the documented date of determination (DOD). The date of determination is the date the student gives written or verbal notice of withdrawal to the institution or the date the institution terminates the student, by applying the institution's attendance, conduct, or Satisfactory Academic Progress policy.

Cancellations:

1. Rejection of Applicant: If an applicant is rejected for enrollment by an institution, or if a prospective international student has his/her visa application rejected, a full refund of all tuition monies paid will be made to the applicant.
2. Program Cancellation: If an institution cancels a program subsequent to a student's enrollment, the institution will refund all monies paid by the student.
3. Cancellation Prior to the Start of Class or No Show: If an applicant accepted by the institution cancels prior to the start of scheduled classes or never attends class (no-show), the institution will refund all monies paid, less a maximum application/registration fee of \$200 , if such charges are clearly noted in the enrollment agreement as being non-refundable. An institution may retain any actual housing costs incurred by the institutions and a maximum total of \$500 for any non-refundable charges clearly identified in the enrollment agreement, including any application/registration fee, courier fees, and travel cancellation insurance, when a student is recruited from outside the United States or its territories and possesses a student visa to enter the country for study.
4. Cancellation After the Start of Class: An institution may consider a withdrawal as a cancellation or no show (for example, within the first week of the program) provided this process is fully delineated in writing as part of the refund policy and provided to all students at or before enrollment. A student who is considered a cancellation or no show under such a policy must have all charges refunded and all payments returned to the individual or the applicable funding source less the maximum allowable application/registration fee of \$200.

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If student withdraws from a vocational course Students will not be refunded any money if they voluntarily withdraw from the course after having started the course. If student is discontinued from a vocational course Students will not be refunded any money if they are asked to withdraw from the course.

REFUNDS

A student cancelling enrollment before the start of class and students withdrawing after class starts will be refunded any unused portion of the tuition, fees and other charges. The charges to the eligible person for tuition, fees, and other charges will not exceed the approximate pro-rata portion of the tuition, fees and other charges that the length of the completed portion of the course bears to the total length of the course. DDC will have 30 days after withdrawal or termination to pay any refund due.
